



World Bank Delegation visits Lower Ruvu Water Treatment Plant

On 8th May 2012, a delegation of four World Bank Water Resources experts lead by MCA-T Director of Water Sector Projects visited ongoing expansion of Lower Ruvu Water Treatment Plant ahead of Water Development Sector -Annual Meeting.

In addition to the ongoing expansion of Lower Ruvu Water Treatment plant, the Government of United Republic of Tanzania will construct 1.8m width pipeline from Lower Ruvu to the reservoir at University of Dar es Salaam. On the other hand World Bank will fund construction of Kidunda Dam, a project intended to eventually control flow of Ruvu water supply for the Treatment Plant. Both projects are critical for ongoing MCA-T investment in Water sector .
