

## **INSTALLATION OF SOLAR POWER IN KIGOMA ENHANCES QUALITY OF SOCIAL SERVICES PROVISION**

MCA-T is financing installation of solar panels to supply power to the dispensaries, health centres, secondary schools and markets.

As of November 2012, 43 dispensaries out of 116, 3 health centres out of 14, 17 secondary schools out of 45 and 3 markets out of 25 are already connected with solar power.

Speaking to the MCA-T Project Officer who have visited the site, one of the nurse at Bitale Health Centre reported that they can now attend patients comfortably even during night time using solar lights while some patients said they can take care of their babies during night time with no difficulties and also can see properly what they are eating at night. Before they were just doing it by experience or using faint torches and kerosine lamps.
